

Oshkosh North Girls' Basketball Classic

Rules and Information Sheet



Waiver of Release: The Oshkosh Area School District, Oshkosh High Schools, the supervisor of the tournament, volunteers, and any team managers *shall not be responsible for personal injury of any player or loss of individual property during the tournament.* By playing in this tournament, you adhere to the above waiver.

All games will be governed by WIAA rules where appropriate. Officials' ruling is final.

Rules of exception:

- 1) Two 18-minute halves with running clock.
- 2) The clock will stop the last two minutes of each half. (However, if a team is up by 20 points or more in the second half, the clock will continue to run at the end of the second half.)
- 3) Four-minute halftime.
- 4) Three one-minute timeouts per game.
- 5) One additional one-minute timeout for overtime—NO carryovers.
- 6) Three-minute overtime.
- 7) NO 2nd overtime—one free throw will be taken by each of the five players that *ended overtime.* The team with the most makes after five will be the winner. We will repeat the process until we have a winner. (Team with the possession arrow shoots FIRST – alternate thereafter. Possession arrow will flip with each overtime.)
- 8) Individual and team fouls will be counted. Free throws will be shot on shooting fouls, bonus on the 7th team foul, and double bonus on the 10th foul. (3rd and 4th grade will have a 12 foot free throw line. They may cross the line after the shot. 5th grade may cross the line after shot, but will use the regulation free throw line.)
- 9) A technical foul will result in two points for the other team and possession of the ball. A second technical will result in that player/coach being dismissed from the tournament.
- 10) 3rd and 4th grade: man to man half-court defense. **May press last two minutes of game.**
5th and 6th grade: man to man half-court defense. **May press last two minutes of each half.** 7th-8th: any defense is allowed. ****NO PRESSING UP 20+ AT ANY LEVEL.****
- 11) Warm-up balls will **NOT** be furnished.
- 12) Ice bags will be available for players. Teams should provide their own tape, pre-wrap, etc. *A trainer will not be on site for the tournament.*

NOTE: Doors will open each morning 30 MINUTES BEFORE FIRST GAMES.



Master Schedule:

Make sure you consistently check the master schedule to make sure scores are recorded correctly and you know where your next game is in the event of a last-minute change. Also, check the schedule for the determined bracket round pairings.
